Course Description:

Fascial Layering : The Meeting Between Practitioner and Client

What does it mean to “meet the client where they are at?” What is required from both the practitioner and the client to access the magic of Structural Integration? In this six-day workshop, we will explore our understanding of fascial layering. We will look at how the practitioner can access a place of connection where the client is available, so change can happen. The 4-handed format (two practitioners working with one client) is a unique and profound method for understanding fascial layering. We will also learn specific heart/brain frequency entrainment techniques to help us activate intention and heart-centered presence during our sessions.

Practitioners will exchange a series of three sessions – one or more of these three sessions will be a 4-handed session with David. The practitioners will exchange the other sessions with each other. Practitioners will also work 4-handed with three models, doing two 3-series and a single session. There will be time to talk about and explore any questions, concerns, or experiences, either from the workshop, or in your practice. Suggested readings for this course include “The Genie in Your Genes” by Dawson Church, “Biology of Belief” by Bruce Lipton, “Energy Medicine in Therapeutics and Human Performance” by James Oschman, and “The Secret Teaching of Plants in the Direct Perception of Nature” by Stephen Buhner.

Instructor Biography: Originally trained under Dr. Ida P. Rolf, David Davis brings 30+ years of experience as a SI practitioner to this workshop. David has taught at the Guild for Structural Integration since 1990, and has private practices in Lakewood and Crestone, CO. David believes that the foundational work of the 10-series is a crucial practice for understanding the deeper aspects of SI, and that, at its fullest, the SI work is a creative dance of compassionate presence. David is committed to transmitting this understanding to all of his students.

About Crestone: Crestone, Colorado is located in south-central Colorado, in the northern part of the San Luis Valley, about 2 hours north of Taos, New Mexico. It is nestled in the western foothills of the Sangre de Christo mountain range and adjacent to the Great Sand Dunes National Park.
